- Clubs
- Field trips
- Dances
- Grade Level Privileges
- After School Activities

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By being placed on the 90-day List, students are identified as having forfeited the privilege to participate in extracurricular activities involving Palisades High School. In order to appeal your loss of all extra-curricular privileges for 90 calendar days, the following must be completed and submitted to your administrator.
